



Dr. Bhoomi Mehrotra

Bhoomi Mehrotra, MD was born in a military family in Mhow, Madhya Pradesh, India. After studying in thirteen schools as his parents were transferred across the country, he graduated high school from Delhi Public School, Mathura Road, New Delhi. As a National Merit Scholar, he graduated from Maulana Azad Medical College, University of



Delhi in 1984. He was a post doctoral fellow at the Brain Tumor Research Center and Radiation Oncology Research Laboratory at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) prior to entering his Residency training in Internal Medicine at the Long Island Jewish Medical Center, NY. He returned to UCSF to complete his fellowship training in Hematology, Medical Oncology and Bone Marrow Transplantation.

He is currently the founding Director of the Cancer Institute and Director of Medical Oncology at St. Francis Hospital, The Heart Center, Roslyn, and the Co-Chairman of Oncology Services for the Catholic Health Services of Long Island. He is a member of several academic societies including the American Society of

Clinical Oncology (ASCO) and the American Society of Hematology. He serves on the Editorial Board of ASCO University and is actively engaged in the Maintenance of Certification educational modules for his professional society. He has authored over eighty abstracts, papers, book chapters and reviews which have been presented at major conferences nationally and internationally. He routinely gives educational sessions at professional society conferences and also serves on the Executive Council of the NY Head and Neck Society. His primary interest is in the multi-disciplinary management of solid tumors and to this end has remained an active investigator for institutional and multi-center clinical trials for over twenty years. He has been named consistently as a 'Best Doctor' and 'Top Doctor' by numerous publications including Castle Connolly, New Yorker magazine and Newsday for several years.

Dr. Mehrotra credits his professional achievements to his long time colleagues including Dr. Dilip Patel and Dr. Rajasree Roy and pays special tribute to his lifelong mentor, Dr. Kanti R. Rai, a former honoree of this organization. He credits his ability to function at any and every level to his wife, Dr. Deepti Mehrotra, a Pediatrician, and acknowledges his children, Devi and Arjun, for their unconditional love, inspiration and support. He thanks his parents Shanker and Krishna and his parents' in-law Satish and Santosh Ahuja for their blessings and constant guidance in becoming a better human being.



Honoree

Dr. Surya Vishnubhakat Murthy

Dr. Murthy was born in India in the small and scenic town of Kanker. He enjoyed a wonderful childhood there with his parents and six siblings, many of whom are also physi-



cians. Following completion of his college education in the city of Indore, he entered medical school in 1962 and successfully completed his MBBS. After he finished his thesis titled "Genetic Variation of Isoniazid Metabolism in the Indian Population and Outcome of Tuberculosis," he earned his Doctor of Medicine (MD) and migrated to the United States in 1972. He completed his internship in Internal Medicine and then trained in Neurology at Cornell University Hospital under the tutelage of Doctors Fred Plum, Jerome Posner, and Richard Beresford. He joined North Shore University Hospital and has remained with the institution to date. He also trained with Dr. Peter Tsairis in clinical neurophysiology at the Hospital for Special Surgery.

Dr. Murthy established his first electromyography lab at North Shore University Hospital in 1976 and the first evoked potential lab in 1979. He was the first to establish the neuro-on-cology program in 1976 through 1986 for the treatment of malignant glioma under the NIH sponsored BTSG protocols headed by Dr. William R. Shapiro. He however remained dedicated to clinical neurophysiology and started neuromuscular and EMG fellowship training programs followed by clinical neurophysiology fellowship training. To date, he continues to direct the clinical neurophysiology fellowship training program.

Dr. Murthy is currently Vice Chair of the Department of Neurology for the North Shore LIJ Medical Group, the Associate Professor at the Hofstra Medical School, Director of Clinical Neurophysiology and Senior Attending Neurologist at North Shore University Hospital. Dr. Murthy takes pride not only in being a neurologist and neurophysiologist, but also in being a devoted teacher, husband and father. He has been blessed with a dedicated wife, three loving children, and two beautiful grandchildren. He enjoys music, traditional Indian literature, history and most of all, the company of his friends. He finds that there is nothing more wonderful in life than to have good friends, a loving family and the ability to teach and to continuously learn. Learning is a lifelong business.



Honoree

Dr. Ramanathan Raju, MD, MBA, FACS, FACHE

Ramanathan (Ram) Raju, MD, MBA, FACS, FACHE is the President and Chief Executive Officer of the New York City Health and Hospitals Corporation (HHC), the largest municipal healthcare



system in the nation. Dr. Raju was appointed by New York City Mayor Bill de Blasio in January 2014 to lead the 37,000 employees of this \$7 billion corporation, which includes 11 acute care hospitals, five nursing homes, six large diagnostic and treatment centers, more than 70 community-based health centers, a large home care agency, and one of the New York area's largest providers of government-sponsored health insurance, MetroPlus Health Plan, the plan of choice for nearly half a million New Yorkers. Last year, HHC facilities served 1.4 million New Yorkers -- including more than 475,000 uninsured.

Prior to accepting the role of President and CEO at HHC, Dr. Raju was the Chief Executive Officer for the Cook County Health & Hospitals System (CCHHS) in Chicago, Illinois. CCHHS is the third largest public health system in the country, overseeing a comprehensive, integrated system of healthcare, comprised of two hospitals; a regional

outpatient center; a correctional healthcare facility; an outpatient infectious disease center specializing in the treatment of HIV/AIDS; 16 community clinics and a nationally accredited public health department. During his tenure there, Dr. Raju obtained federal approval for a Section 1115 Medicaid Waiver permitting CCHHS to "early enroll" under the ACA Medicaid expansion, reduced the structural deficit by more than \$200M, and gained meaningful designation throughout the health system.

Dr. Raju began his medical career in the United States at Lutheran Medical Center in Brooklyn and went on to serve as the COO and Medical Director at HHC's Coney Island Hospital. Then in 2006, he became the HHC Chief Medical Officer, Corporate Chief Operating Officer and Executive Vice President. While he served there, HHC continued to climb and reach great heights in quality, patient safety and healthcare data transparency. He was also an integral part of the team that embarked, in 2010, on the HHC restructuring and cost containment plan.

Dr. Raju attended Madras Medical College to earn his medical diploma and his Master of Surgery degree. He underwent further training in England and was elected as a Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons. Dr. Raju is also a physician executive, having obtained an MBA from the University of Tennessee and CPE from the American College of Physician Executives.

Dr. Raju is the recipient of numerous national recognitions, including being named to lists of the 100 Most Influential Healthcare Leaders in 2014, the 50 most influential Physician Executives in Healthcare in 2013, 2014, and 2015. Top 25 Minority Executives in Health care for 2012 and 2014, all by Modern Healthcare, and Becker's top 25 Health care executives to follow in Twitter.

He serves on Boards of Directors, including the American Hospital Association, America's Essential Hospitals (formerly the National Association of Public Hospitals), the Greater New York Hospital Association, and the Healthcare Association of New York State.

A langtime resident of Staten Island, Dr. Raju and his wife, a physician, and have two children.

Honoree

Dr. Jagan Pahuja

Dr. Jagan Pahuja is a dedicated and highly regarded physician who was recently recognized by the Medical Society of the State of New York for his 50 years of devoted service to the public in the practice of medicine.



From his humble beginnings as one of 10 siblings, born in Multan, India, (a region that is now Pakistan), his career spans 3 continents, 5 decades and a penchant for service not only in medicine but also in professional, social and community organizations – many of which also support medical and/or charitable endeavors.

He graduated from Medical College Amritsar, Punjab, India and was then able to indulge his passion for travel by working as a physician in the Indian Railways. Then, when the opportunity presented itself for higher studies (and further travel) outside of India, Dr. Pahuja moved, with his wife and young daughter, to England, working in Bristol, Dartford, and Aylesbury. Dr. Pahuja is Board Certified in Pediatrics and Pediatric Endocrinology. He is a fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics and also a


